WHAT is NMNEC?

The New Mexico Nursing Education Consortium is a collaborative of all eighteen state-funded nursing programs offering associate (ADN) and baccalaureate (BSN) degree programs. These schools are committed to: 1. implementing a common nursing curriculum and 2. building partnerships between universities and community colleges to offer the bachelor's degree on community college campuses.

NMNEC HISTORY

In 2014, the pre-licensure BSN degree was offered in two state-funded universities (UNM and NMSU). Because of the efforts of the consortium, today, the BSN-degree option is offered in ten schools in all four quadrants of the state. In the coming years, this opportunity will be available in all eighteen state-funded nursing programs.
