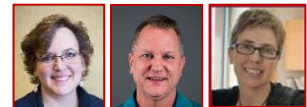

Reimbursement Submission Date: *(form will be emailed to attendees on April 9th)*

Reimbursement Form and supporting documentation must be emailed to nmneec@salud.unm.edu by **5pm April 30th** to be considered.

Supporting Documentation:

Mileage: google map displaying travel route and verifying roundtrip mileage

Hotel/ Airfare: paid receipt showing zero balance

Hotel Reimbursement (up to \$150 per night per person):

One night reimb for 71-to-250 miles traveled one-way

Two nights reimb for 251+ miles traveled one-way

In-state Mileage Reimbursement Rates:

(no restrictions for single drivers or carpool drivers)

Roundtrip mileage may be reimbursed at the federal rate of .545¢ per mile for your personal vehicle or school vehicle.

Please supply the “Supporting Documentation” requested in the reimbursement form.
