

# NMNEC Nurse Educator Endowment AWARD

## Donor Purpose Statement:

*This fund supports Nurse Educators involved with NMNEC: travel costs associated with attending NMNEC workshops, and nurses who are enrolled in UNM MSN-Education program with GPA in good standing and are committed to teaching within the NMNEC system. Preference for funding will be given to those participants who are enrolled in UNM College of Nursing MSN-Education program.*

Two (2) annual monetary awards will be distributed as follows:

- A. \$1000 for travel expenses to attend NMNEC workshops (in-state mileage reimbursement, hotel, and per diem). Eligible recipients are faculty currently teaching the NMNEC curriculum OR UNM MSN-Education program participants in good standing who are committed to teaching within the NMNEC system.
- B. \$1000 scholarship for a currently-enrolled UNM MSN-Education student.

## Nominees:

- Faculty currently teaching the NMNEC Curriculum may self-nominate
- Students currently enrolled in the UNM MSN-Education program may self-nominate
