NMNEC Progression Policy*

(approved by a simple majority vote of Full Member schools 5.5.14)

Level 1:

One course failure/withdrawal – dismissed from program; must apply for readmission to program. Each school will determine whether readmission is possible based on a number of variables. (Examples of variables: course offerings, faculty availability, seat availability, other).

Two course failures/withdrawals - dismissed from program; may reapply after two years.

Levels 2, 3, 4, 5:

Second course failure/withdrawal - dismissed from program and may reapply after two years.

This policy applies to all nursing courses in NMNEC statewide curriculum degree plans. Course failures and withdrawals cumulate from Level 1 through Level 5 and across all NMNEC programs.

**This policy does not apply to course failures for pre-requisites and co-requisites. (This clarification was added by the NMNEC Leadership Council 10/12/17.)*
