NMNEC Course Numbers represent the following:

NMNC	NMNEC courses - guaranteed to share 100% course descriptions and objectives
First digit	Represents (for CCs) the first or second half of the curriculum. University numbers are 2000 higher than any CC numbering
Second digit	Represents the level of nursing coursework by semester, in sequence
Third digit	Course sequence within a semester - 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th
Fourth digit	"0" represents a didactic class; "5" indicates a course with a clinical component
