Planning for implementation of 2017 NMNEC Curriculum Evaluation Plan

- Since two new members were in attendance, the plan for implementing the curriculum review was reiterated. The members discussed the need to identify level champions from programs and form "level groups" comprised of faculty who have developed/taught in those levels, as well as faculty in programs that are late adopters.
- Members identified topics that need to be addressed as part of the curriculum review:
 - 1) Any variances from the original NMNEC blueprints
 - 2) How are exemplars being presented?
 - 3) Clinical evaluation tool – how are programs making it fit various clinical experiences?
 - 4) ABG's, Rounding Rules, Medical Terminology – how have these issues been addressed?
 - 5) Intro to Concepts course – how are programs teaching this?
 - 6) Pharmacology – how is this being introduced (i.e. intro as Safety concept in Intro to Concepts course in L1)? How is it threaded throughout the curriculum?
 - 7) Has your program added or subtracted any exemplars/content areas based on EBP or other identified programmatic needs?
 - 8) Does your program utilize a standardized testing product? If so, have any areas of weakness been consistently identified?
 - 9) Test-taking strategies – is this taught/addressed in your program? How?

- A letter will be drafted by M. Wright and the Curriculum Committee to all Program Directors asking for Level Champions to be identified to volunteer for level group work.

- A draft program survey will be developed incorporating the ideas formulated by the Committee today. The draft will be reviewed at the next meeting (and members will bring any additional items to be considered) and survey will be finalized.

10) Student success support – what level of support is available

- The members agreed that once level groups are formed, we will need to determine a method for distributing the workload and a schedule to re-convene the entire committee to monitor progress.
