<b>NMNEC LPN Admission Criteria Policy Draft</b>	Draft policy of LPN Admission Criteria was provided, reviewed, and approved.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sabrina will take to LC on Thursday 10/26 for review. <b>LPN NMNEC curriculum</b>	<p>HS Level - LPN HS curriculum draft was presented for feedback. The curriculum utilized existing Level 1 thru part of Level 3 NMNEC curriculum. Diane noted that the existing NMNEC curriculum is designed for RN scope of practice and that courses required college level prerequisites which could not be fulfilled at the HS level as documented in the NMNEC POS. Tracy also felt uncomfortable with the existing NMNEC course content being taught at the LPN level. Sabrina noted that CCC is using the NMNEC curriculum for their LPN program. Diane pointed out that the courses needed to reflect LPN scope of practice.</p> <p>Jenny, Terry and Sabrina Coulie will work on a new version of a concept-based LPN curriculum for the HS level, possibly incorporating the current Intro to Concepts and Principles of Nursing Practice Courses.</p> <p>College level LPN NMNEC curriculum – Jenny suggested that a survey be sent out to determine the need for a college level LPN curriculum.</p> <p>Diane mentioned that CNM is looking at an LPN program for their ABE program.
