<p>Progress Report on Genetics/Genomics Concept</p>	<p>Dr Tinkle can present draft concept at statewide meeting for review.</p> <p>Need further discussion on where concept should reside and question was raised whether it should be presented as a MegaConcept. Reviewed concept graphic, would possibly be another concept area under participant attribute. Concept is interrelated and threads through participant attributes. Right now seems to fit best in the participant attribute area.</p> <p>Need to hear ideas and recommendations on how to implement into curriculum before final decision.</p> <p>As additional details become available, it may become apparent where it lives. Final decision to be made after seeing further details.</p>	<p>Needs further discussion.</p>
<p>Review Concept Overview Revisions</p>	<p><u>General:</u> Intent is to create a document that communicates to users the major changes in concepts. Document will also be used to ensure changes are correct in final editing, matches with core syllabi and clean up discrepancies between various documents.</p> <p><u>Metabolism</u> Need to approve definition change. Discussion: two line definition accepted. Complete new definition: “Chemical and hormonal processes that influence cellular, tissue, or organ functions. Describes the processes of biochemical reactions that are necessary to produce energy, repair body’s cells and maintain life.”</p> <p><u>Safety</u> Need clarification on whether Nursing Sensitive Indicators be listed as NMNEC required exemplars rather than optional.</p> <p>Currently only two required exemplars: National Patient Safety Goals QSEN (Quality and Safety Education for Nurses)</p> <p>Discussion: Do they fall in other curriculum or span clinical practice and education areas? Are they in National and QSEN? If covered under national patient safety goals, then why would we list these as optional, appears redundant. Can optional be eliminated?</p> <p><u>Sensory Perception</u> Need Clarification – may be discrepancy between syllabi and concept – Mary will update concept map</p> <p><u>Other Related Topic Discussion</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •As a courtesy, Mary would like permission to list names of those making revisions and send out to committee •Who will have concepts done by 5/15? 	<p>Move two sentence definition for Metabolism forward</p> <p>Agreed to remove the optional Nursing Sensitive Indicator exemplars from Safety as all of the Nursing Sensitive Indicators are already included in the required National Patient Safety Goals exemplar.</p> <p>Mary will update concept maps and course syllabi in relation to Sensory Perception exemplars.</p>

Info on possible upcoming proposal to add SBIRT as possible exemplar	<p>SBIRT – Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment SBIRT is used for early intervention aimed at risky behavior, not existing substance abuse problems. Is a statewide initiative. NMNEC needs to sustain and identify where in the curriculum it would be appropriate. Possibility it may be added as an exemplar.</p>	Informational; will possibly require further discussion in the future
