<p>Old Business</p> <p>NMNEC Student Feedback.Satisfaction Survey/What quantitative questions to ask in 2018-2019 based on concepts and program/level objectives?</p>	<p>Reviewed draft questions submitted by Siri GuruNam Khalsa based on suggested questions on ‘Measuring Student Perception of Achievement of Course Learning Outcomes’ in Giddens, Rogers, Caputi publication.</p> <p>Discussed what the focus of the student feedback survey should be that would provide the information needed by NMNEC to evaluate the NMNEC common statewide curriculum. Since the NMNEC curriculum is concept-based, evaluating student perceptions related to curricular concepts would be useful. Do students perceive that they are understanding concepts? Do students see linkages of concepts to the nursing care they provide patients? At the same time, since level curricular objectives are linked with the NMNEC curricular outcomes, student perception of their achievement of the level objectives would provide NMNEC with information about achievement of program outcomes To summarize, student feedback survey should focus on measuring the student perception of student:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understanding of concepts • application of concepts to patient care • achievement of level outcomes <p>Discussed focusing draft questions to these areas of focus. Want to maximize ease of data collection and evaluation of data by building quantitative questions and minimizing use of qualitative questions. Discussed pros and cons of asking about teaching methods/strategies on a consortium level. Might best be evaluated at the school level?</p> <p>Discussed whether realistic to meet goal of July 1, 2018 to have new survey ready.</p> <p>Decided to change goal for implementation of new survey to be January 1, 2019. Will continue to use current student survey until then. The committee recommended not doing the same detailed analysis of the 2017-2018 data as was done on the 2016-2017 data and focus on survey revision and implementation. The committee recommends that each school look at own data for the 2016-2017 year.</p>	<p>For next meeting, Mary will draft some general survey questions to review based on meeting discussion.</p>
