<b>Old Business</b> • Minutes	Reviewed minutes from 9.18.18 meetings	Motion to approve by Susan Wayne, second by Jonathon Lumibao. Minutes from 09.18.18 approved.
<b>New Business</b> Validate that sim plan concepts/exemplars match with assigned curricular concepts/exemplars	<p><u>Psychomotor Skills: Level 2:</u> very lengthy (reproductive set of skills)-are they required or suggested? Herica says required.</p> <p>Drew mentions that we should specify that all listed concepts/exemplars do not have to be done in a high fidelity setting and/or separate these into separate scenarios.</p> <p>At UNM-A, we complete these simulation requirements in a mid or low-fidelity setting with faculty conducting scenarios</p> <p>SJC-theater style (3-4 students at a time with 6-8 observers), debrief, then move into next scenario, debrief, move to next, debrief.</p> <p><u>Discussion of the Levels</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Level 1:</b> discrepancy: Mobility, Med Admin is not concept in NMNEC curric. Fall Risk and med error are not exemplars in curric.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No Decisions at this meeting.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• While they may not be curricular concepts but they are high risk, failure to rescue scenarios which graduates need, right?</li> <li>• Repeating concepts (like med admin) make sim/curricular program stronger</li> <li>• Med admin can be included as NPSG and under that, a specific scenario including latent error. Med admin rights can be repeated in each level to make</li> <li>• So exemplar is NPSG, not med admin? Correct.</li> <li>• Can the “mobility” concept become “Safety” as it encompasses falls, med errors, etc?</li> </ul> <p><u>Level 2</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• PTSD content-should it be in L2?</li> <li>• Low fidelity or SP scenario to display PTSD is being used at several colleges</li> <li>• Can Shadow Health be substituted? Maybe we can decide what substitution is acceptable.</li> <li>• Can we break up the reproductive exemplars into separate vignettes? Can all schools handle the time this will take? AND the high fidelity (newborn) that it might take?</li> </ul> <p><u>Level 3</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• EOL is supposed to be in L3, not L4. DKA and hypoglycemia are not exemplars assoc with Metabolism, DM is.</li> <li>• Should we move EOL to L3? Not deciding today, but need to vote eventually.</li> </ul> <p><u>Level 4</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cardiac options are many, choose 1</li> <li>• No major discrepancy</li> </ul> <p><u>Level 5</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cardiac arrest is not exemplar</li> <li>• Good place for bioterrorism with isolation etc.</li> </ul>
