Mary Wright met with Becky Dakin, NMNEC Program Manager, to review the budget for funds received for the 2018-2019 fiscal year from the NM Board of Nursing. Each faculty member who reviews new concepts will receive \$150 with a max number of concepts reviewed for the year being 28 concepts.</p> <p>Feedback from the NMNEC Leadership Council on getting enough volunteers is that after the this committee has solicited volunteers, if there are still concepts that need review, the Leadership Council will assign them out to schools for faculty members to review.</p> <p>Mary Wright presented a written concept review process in order to illustrate guidelines for keeping NMNEC concepts relevant and up to date.
