Progress report on NMNEC Stimulation taskforce	No one was present to give presentation	Deferred to next meeting
Review of Genomics Concept	Discussion on placement of Genomics concept in NMNEC curriculum. Reported that some faculty felt that genomics concept was inappropriate for level one introductory courses and there was agreement that if it goes into level one as an intro-level course, it would need to be followed up on and expanded in level 2. Other faculty think it belongs in L1 given its complexity as it would allow faculty to build on it through the levels as genetics can be too complex to be in one place in the curriculum. Some faculty think it should be placed in Level 2 and some think it belonged in L4.	Connie suggested doing a proposal for next meeting when more are in attendance and save vote for next meeting.
Review of Immunity Concept Revision	Discussion on whether or not socioeconomic fit in within the concept. Ethnicity was also proposed as fitting within the parameters of the concept with some concerns that stereotyping illnesses to races and ethnicities might be problematic.	Committee will present feedback to James Vigil and allow him to determine how to proceed.
Progress report on NMNEC Concept reviews 2018-19	Committee reviewed the list of concepts and discussed finding more volunteers to review the remaining concepts. Concept deadline is January 11.	Committee agrees to find faculty to finish leftover concepts by December 7 th .

Review of Psychomotor Skills Document	Committee reviewed updated 2018 Psychomotor Skills document	Committee Approved Document. Updated document to be submitted to NMNEC Leadership Council.
NCSBN Medical Marijuana Guidelines	Committee discussed if or how the NCSBN Medical Marijuana guidelines for patients would fit in with NMNEC concepts. It was mentioned that this has been briefly discussed within L3 Comfort concept in some programs. It could also fit in well somewhere in L3 or L4, in either Comfort or in Behavior-Addictions, and should include covering both the pros and cons of medical marijuana use. Suggestion made about introducing it into Pharmacology. Committee agreed that it wouldn't make for an exemplar, but it could be added into different areas throughout the levels.	Committee will discuss with faculty whether or not to include Medical Marijuana in Pharmacology courses. Committee will revisit discussion at the next meeting.
