Finish the L2 simulation F&E and reproduction activities review	<p>Herica Torres provided brief review of L1 and asks for any additional edits. No edits at this time.</p> <p>Client vs patient within the Simulation Plan document: Mary was attempting to address the adjustment but realized that the NMNEC competencies utilize "patient" so an adjustment could be very confusing and not allowed due to NMNEC curriculum requirements.</p> <p>Reproduction activities discussion: Herica reminded participants why reproductive activities could be included in the skills lab areas as opposed to high fidelity simulation.</p> <p>Should this information live in the simulation plan? <u>Addendum:</u> "Modified Simulation"?</p>	<p>Information only – no action.</p> <p>Task Force approved the retention of the word "patient" as opposed to changing to client.</p> <p>Task force approved to: Addendum: "Required Simulation activity"-but does not have to be at a high fidelity level (due to limited resources, equipment etc)</p>

	<p><u>Ante-, Intra-, Post-Partum and Newborn assessment</u> Discussion on stations of activities with student rotations (shoulder dystocia, umbilical cord prolapse, postpartum hemorrhage)— mentioned that these are specialty topics and not tied to the NMNEC reproduction content. Normal wellness/ health promotion and assessment topics are to be covered in L2 according to NMNEC curricular map as opposed to complications. Activities: discussion and approval in the action column Immunization will be added to a required newborn assessment</p> <p>Discussion of the results of the task force ‘homework’ survey related to what L2 concepts and exemplars should be included in L2 Fluid & Electrolyte scenario, plus the psychomotor skills, clinical judgment, communication items, and NMNEC competencies that should be assigned.</p> <p>Fluid volume deficit-assessment and interpretation of VS, labs, intervention will be outside scope of Level</p> <p>Kidney condition-not complicated, education on diet and lifestyle changes, communicate with healthcare team, intervention will be PO med.</p> <p>Acute kidney failure r/t fluid volume deficit</p> <p>Still addressing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Psychomotor skills: Full assessment, monitor VS, I&O • communication items: healthcare team, patient and/or family • clinical judgment: identify abnormal assessment, recognize need for • NMNEC competencies 	<p>Approved by the committee: Ante-partum: fetal assessment, assessment of normal pregnant woman, recognition of abnormal findings Intra-partum: Uncomplicated Vaginal delivery of fetus and placenta (with use of multimedia as a minimum) Post-partum: postpartum assessment of mother, promotion of health in the post-partum period (i.e., administration of Rhogam, prevention of bladder distention, fundal massage, breastfeeding) Newborn assessment: assessment of newborn (with use of multimedia as minimum), promotion of health in the newborn (i.e., Vitamin K injection, erythromycin eye ointment, newborn metabolic screening, immunization of the newborn (Hep B)</p> <p>Task force approved: Concepts and exemplars for first L2 simulation on Health Promotion and Assessment to be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Concept: F&E <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Exemplar: Non-Acute, Uncomplicated Renal Failure <p>Will be added to the NMNEC Simulation Plan revision that is in progress.</p> <p>Task Force members to receive document with results of this meeting’s Fluid and Electrolyte simulation ideas and each member to highlight the suggested psychomotor skills, communication, items clinical judgment items, and competencies that think should be included.
