Robin Jones – Patho common course	Dr. Robin Jones joined the call to share the quandary with Patho in regard to HED's mandate to define this as a common course. The challenge with this is Patho is delivered by several different departments – sometimes through nursing, and often not. Credits vary from 3-6. Some deliver this in one term, some in two. Dr. Jones pointed out that the state will require one common Patho course. The other Patho courses that fall outside this definition will have to apply as a "Unique Course" with a different name such as "Pathology for Healthcare." Dr. Jones expressed concern with the possible lower funding for unique courses versus health courses. Dr. Jones did not request a decision, just wanted to inform LC that this is coming down the line and will be a challenge. LC determined to keep an eye on this. Diane clarified that they would need to divert from the current definition of a community college and would ask that this be redefined. Diane shared that there are several disciplines that are now requiring the bachelor degree as opposed to the associate – Respiratory, PT Aid, Buss & Tech. Diane said that this may become part of a new model for NMNEC. Other states (Florida) have community colleges conferring bachelor degrees. This is a movement across the nation.	None
