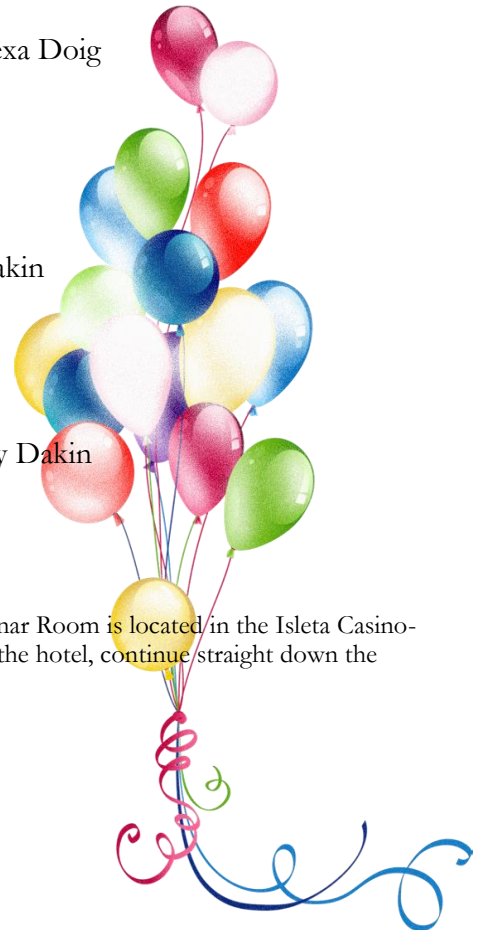

- (If applicable) Attach Hotel receipt: paid receipt showing zero balance
- (If applicable) Attach in-state Airfare receipt: paid flight receipt showing zero balance

ALLOWABLE EXPENSES & Reimbursement Rates for In-state Hotel/Mileage dependent upon your one-day or two-day meeting registration:

- Hotel Reimb **for those traveling more than 50 miles one way:** up to \$110 per person per night
 - 1-2 nights hotel reimb for 51-to-300 miles one way
 - 2-3 nights reimb for >300 miles one way
- Mileage: .545¢ per mile
