

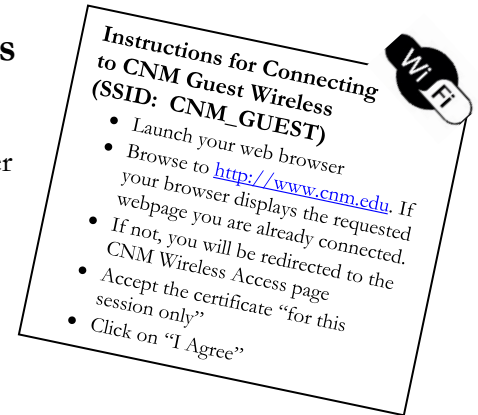

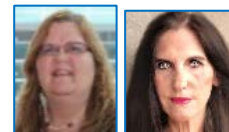

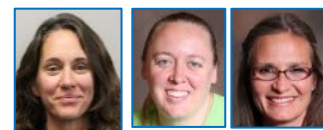

- (If applicable) Attach in-state Airfare receipt: paid flight receipt showing zero balance

ALLOWABLE EXPENSES & Reimbursement Rates for In-state Hotel/Mileage:

Carpools of 2+

- Hotel Reimb: up to \$100 per person per night
 - 1 night hotel reimb for 71-to-300 miles one way
 - 2 nights reimb for >300 miles one way
- Mileage: >50 miles, up to **\$50 flat fee** (.545¢ per mile)

Single Drivers

- Hotel Reimb: up to \$50 total
- Mileage: >50 miles up to **\$50 flat fee** (.545¢ per mile)

In-state Boutique Air Flyers: Airfare reimbursement up to \$150
