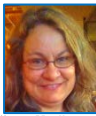

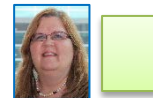

We will review the requirements of clinical courses as developed by NMNEC and as linked to accreditation. We will then have a guided discussion of how to teach concepts in a clinical setting.



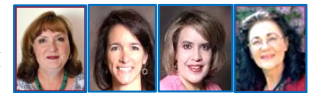

TRAVEL Reimbursement is available for NMNEC Full Member Schools and has **significant restrictions** as we utilize our limited grant funds. Other attendees may request reimbursement and will be provided if funds are available.

### **Reimbursement Submission Date:**

*(form will be emailed to attendees November 5<sup>th</sup> and is also available on the NMNEC website homepage – bottom right)*

- **DUE DATE:** Reimbursement Form and supporting documentation must be emailed to nm nec@salud.unm.edu BEFORE December 1, 2018 to be considered

### **REQUIRED Documentation:**

- Complete and return the NMNEC Travel Reimbursement form
- (If applicable) Attach Hotel receipt: paid receipt showing zero balance
- (If applicable) Attach in-state Airfare receipt: paid flight receipt showing zero balance

### **ALLOWABLE EXPENSES & Reimbursement Rates for In-state Hotel/Mileage:**

#### ***Carpools of 2+***

- Hotel Reimb: up to \$100 per person
  - 1 night hotel reimb for 71-to-300 miles one way
  - 2 nights reimb for >300 miles one way
- Mileage: >50 miles, up to **\$50 flat fee** (.545¢ per mile)

#### ***Single Drivers***

- Hotel Reimb: up to \$50 total
- Mileage: >50 miles up to **\$50 flat fee** (.545¢ per mile)
