

Anita Reinhardt NMNEC Faculty Endowment FACULTY TEACHING AWARD

Donor Purpose Statement:

The Anita Reinhardt NMNEC Faculty Endowment supports creating and maintaining a sustainable, efficient, statewide collaborative nursing curriculum that meets the needs of students and addresses the nursing shortage in New Mexico. The endowment will support faculty teaching within the NMNEC curriculum. Support for faculty includes, but is not limited to, professional training, professional development, research, travel funds (hotel, rental vehicles, conferences, airfare, etc.). The endowment will support faculty development with preference for work performed in conjunction with NMNEC participating schools. This endowment will not support faculty salaries of any kind.

This annual monetary award (\$1000 for 2020) will be given to a NMNEC nursing faculty in recognition of their contribution to the advancement of the statewide common curriculum via an innovative teaching approach. All faculty teaching in the NMNEC curriculum are eligible to be nominated for this annual award.

Nominations:

- Nominations may be made by the NMNEC School Nursing Program Director, nominee may self-nominate, or nomination may be made by a faculty peer

Please provide:

(Total submission should not exceed three (3) pages in length using 12pt type and 1" margins.)

1. Nominee name, title, and school
2. Nominator name, title
3. Description of an innovative teaching approach the nominee has used in the NMNEC concept-based curriculum. Using no more than 1000 words, the description should also include:
 - a. Outcomes of the teaching strategy
 - b. Classroom & Clinical performance teaching the NMNEC Curriculum
 - c. Attainment of NMNEC statewide goals <https://www.nmnec.org/about-nmnec>
 - d. Contributions to your dept., campus, college, and/or to NMNEC (i.e., committee work or activities)

Review process:

A blinded review of the application will be evaluated by the NMNEC Leadership Council to determine recipient of the award.

Announcement:

The awardee and Program Director will be notified seven days (or sooner) prior to the upcoming Virtual NMNEC Statewide Faculty Meeting in October 2020 where all nominees will be recognized and the award will be granted. We request that all nominees make arrangements to be present at this virtual event.
