Responsibilities include coordination of NMNEC committee meetings, statewide meetings, and reports.




**Mary Wright, MSN, RN, CNS, CNE,** has been appointed as the **NMNEC Transition Director.**

Implementation Start Date(s): Within 2022-2023 academic year; starting with Fall 22 or Sp 23; no later than Su 23

**Introduction to Nursing Concepts:**

Comfort concept added  
Genetics concept moved to L2  
ADN-only: Updated Evidence concept with new exemplars

**Evidence-Based Practice:**  
Evidence concept updated with new exemplars

**Principles in Nursing:**  
Nutrition and Elimination concepts added  
L1 Psychomotor Skills updated (includes accompanying focused assessments)  
L1 Competencies updated  
L1 Simulation plan updated

NMNEC Faculty access of updated curricular documents [or pre-update documents until program implements updates] is on NMNEC website:  
Faculty Login/Level 1 Courses (Master Syllabi, Concepts, Clinical Evals, Etc.)

Note: Check with your Program Director as to when your program is starting the rollout of the curricular updates – either Fall 2022 or Spring 2023.

### NMNEC has new Clinical Evaluation Tool TEMPLATES!



Implementation to start in Fall 2022  
[no later than Spring 2023]

NMNEC Curriculum Committee made revisions to the NMNEC Clinical Evaluations. After being piloted by several programs over a 1.5 year period and feedback incorporated, the new NMNEC Clinical Evaluation Tool TEMPLATES were approved for use by both the Curriculum Committee and the NMNEC Leadership Council.

Changes include:

- Use of level competencies and objectives instead of only course objectives and competencies
- Formative and summative evaluations combined into one form
- Program-specific evaluation criteria can easily be added
- Can be used as either an electronic form or as a template for program-specific clinical evaluation platforms.
