No changes

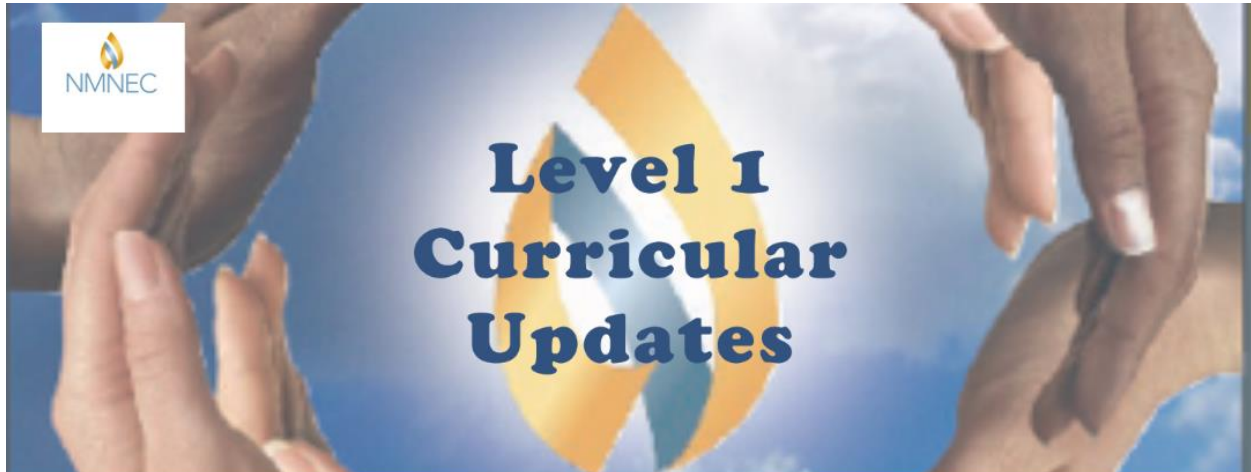

L1 Simulation plan updated

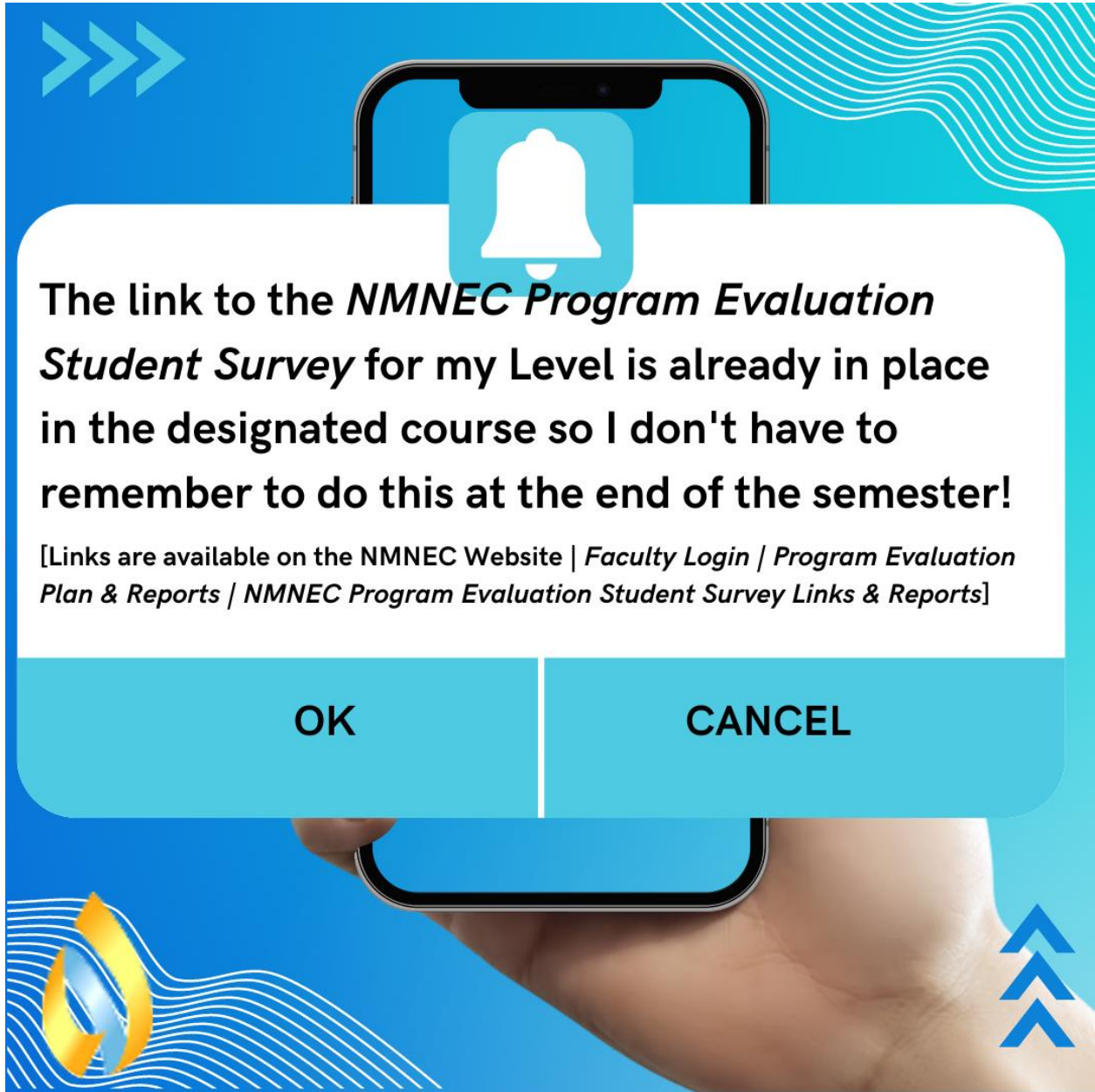
